

WEPBI's Landmark Achievements in the WVL Project

- 169 women sworn in as members of traditional council cabinets in 22 communities in Enugu State.
- 37 women in town Union Executive.
- 23 women in neighborhood watch, increasing women's involvement in decision making on security matters.
- Over 700 women trained for leadership roles both in rural and urban areas.
- 5 women became Counselors at ward level.
- 1st female president in Computer Science Department IMT Enugu.
- 1st female student became Deputy Chief Judge, student senate, IMT Enugu.
- Commissioner of girls guide in Enugu state is a beneficiary of Women leadership academy.
- Executive Director of WEPBI, given a Chieftaincy title of Ada Ife [Daughter of Light], in recognition of her efforts.
- Igwe Umuwanyị of Ndeagbor coronated.
